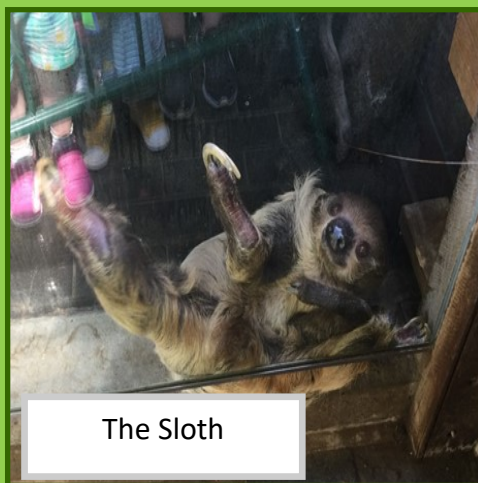

Mill Lane Bridge Project

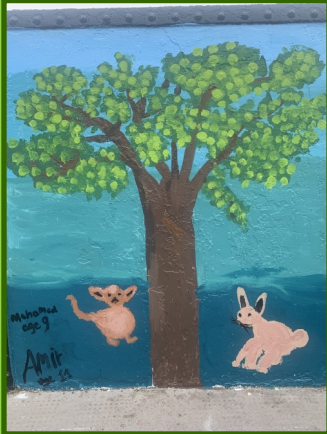


Mill Lane Bridge project was led by local residents in partnership with local primary schools. The original murals were painted by school children as a Millennium Project in August 2000 .
