

<b>Geography</b> Learning about places in the world.	<b>Near</b> Something close-by. <b>Far</b> Something that is not close.	<b>Beach</b> Land next to the sea which is usually pebbly or sandy.	<b>Cliff</b> A steep wall of rock.	<b>Coast</b> The area where sea and land meet.	<b>Forest</b> A place where there are mostly trees.	<b>Hill</b> A piece of land that rises higher than everything around it.	<b>Mountain</b> Is higher and steeper than a hill.	<b>Ocean</b> A huge amount of saltwater. <b>Sea</b> Is smaller than an ocean and made up of saltwater.	<b>River</b> The path that water takes as it flows over land, made of freshwater.	<b>Valley</b> A long, low area of land, often between mountains and hills.	<b>Vegetation</b> The plant life of an area.	<b>Port</b> A place where boats can go to load and unload their supplies.	<b>Harbour</b> A safe place for ships and boats to stay.
